INTERNSHIP COMPONENT

EVANGELISM

Our goal is that all interns will see evangelism as a part of their lifestyle, not just a scheduled activity. Having said that, we will have times of scheduled outreach to help you incorporate evangelism into your life. We will practice evangelism in groups of two to three regularly throughout the year.

PRAYER & WORSHIP

We believe prayer and worship is the key to seeing any great move of God. Everyday we will spend time in prayer and worship together. We will also host a weekly "Open Worship Night" where we will worship and pray with others in our community.

LIFE-ON-LIFE DISCIPLESHIP

We will eat together regularly, go on outreach together, even do "bootcamp" exercises together. Abide is not another program to attend, it's a community to join that will grow you to become more like Jesus as we Abide together.

CERTIFICATION COMPONENT

The Certificate IV in Christian Ministry & Theology (10742NAT) is intended to provide participants with a range of knowledge and skills to perform the following functions in a Christian ministry context:

- Identify, interpret and compare information related to basic Christian beliefs.
- Provide information related to Christian beliefs and understandings to some Christian and some non-Christian audiences.
- Propose what actions are appropriate in a range of life and ministry situations based on interpretations about Christian beliefs.





CERTIFICATE IV IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY AND THEOLOGY

The course consists of six core units and three electives and may be studied full-time or part-time, face to face or online. The course takes one year to complete full-time. The units include:

COMMUNITY DAYS

Monday and Tuesday will be allocated for you to spend time in the community. If you are living in Warragul, this means time either at a local workplace, school, or other space that connects you to community. You can also spend this time alongside the YFC team.

ABIDE DAYS

Wednesday to Friday are Abide Days. A typical Abide Day looks like this:

- Bootcamp: Exercises, Bible and Coffee!
- Breakfast Club at a local school
- Study time (The Online Component will be worked through together as a group. Assessments and further study will be completed in your own time)
- Lunch
- Teaching: On one of the four core values of Abide Identity, Righteousness,
 Missions and Community
- Evangelism: Some of us will head down the street to share the love of Jesus at the local skatepark, shopping centres and cafes while others of us will spend time running discipleship groups with local high school students.

WEEKENDS

Free time.

An Abide requirement is that you become a part of a local church community.



FINANCIALS

We don't believe that finance should be an obstacle to your spiritual development and as such we have worked hard to keep the internship as financially viable as possible.

The Certificate IV is AUSTUDY approved, if you study full-time, meaning you can be paid an allowance from Centrelink. Please speak with us if you have questions in regards to the Youth for Christ component.

COURSE FEE

Cert IV Qualification \$2,800



AUSTUDY

The Course qualifies you for AUSTUDY when studying full-time (the full internship is considered full-time.)

AUSTUDY is a fortnightly Centrelink payment. For singles who are studying full-time, you may be able to receive a payment of up to \$925 a month.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are there any academic requirements?

There are no academic requirements. However, Eastern College Australia will assess your learning needs through an interview. There are no academic requirements from Youth for Christ either, however we will also assess your suitability for the internship through an interview.

Can I do the internship part-time?

The Abide Internship is a full-time commitment, as we want you to live your life Abiding with Christ all the time. You can undertake it part-time if needed. Please contact us if you'd like to discuss this option. Please note however, the minimum time you will need to spend in Warragul with us is 3 days a week, Wednesday to Friday.

Is it possible to have a casual job on the weekends?

Yes! In fact we would encourage you to have a casual job on the weekends. We have also made room for you to work on Mondays and Tuesdays as well if you would like. If you don't want/need to work on Mondays and Tuesdays, there will still be plenty to do in the community with the YFC team.

I don't live in the Warragul area, but keen. Any advice?

We'd love you to move to Warragul and we even have families ready to host you. We appreciate you would have a lot of further questions around a move like that and welcome you to contact us. We believe that discipleship is best done in person, life on life.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I commute from Melbourne?

Yes you can, but we'd prefer it if you lived in Warragul for the same reasons as above. But, if you are in Melbourne and need to commute, that is totally fine. Warragul is only 45 minutes East of Melbourne's Eastern Suburbs.

I'm not a "Young Person". Can I apply?

Absolutely! If you have a heart for young people, the Abide Internship and Youth for Christ is all about the Youth of Australia. You don't have to be a Youth, you just need to have a heart to walk with youth.

Will I need my own car?

No. We have a bus that can pick you up each day for the internship and drop you off at night. Also, Warragul is a very walkable town. Depending on where your host family is, you may be able to walk to the YFC base and downtown too. For those outside of town, Warragul has a great train station and we will happily pick you up from there each morning and drop you off each evening.


